Take your time to watch the film clips before you practice the patterns and make sure that you can remember some of the vocabulary. You can listen to the story, and then perhaps mute the sound and have a go at reading one or two of the phrases yourself. This week our pattern is all about saying how we are feeling by using these phrases: Sut wyt ti? Dw i'n..... You can also find out how other people are feeling. The story this week finds out how each of the friends are feeling. We have a band of the week: Calan who play traditional music in a very modern way.
