2	Tuesday Activity 2 Music Activity This activity may help you with your literacy activity writing a spooky story. Mason Bates is an American composer who wrote music about fantastic animals in 2015. The link below has films that you can play. The first film tells you all about an animal called the A Bao a Qu (it's a made up animal.) Listen to the film. Then go somewhere cosy and listen to the whole piece of music on the second film.
