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
Weekly Home Learning - Year 5

	Maths Activities	Completed
1	<p>This week, we will be starting our 'Fractions' block of work. Your division work from last week should help you complete some of the questions. Click on the 'Fractions' section and choose a fraction to cover. Challenge yourself by decreasing your allocated time. You can scan this QR code for quick access.</p>  <p>There will also be MyMaths challenges to complete.</p>	
2	<p>Revision of Division</p> <p>Last week, we looked at short division, let's see how well you have remembered and understood the topic!</p> <p>Can you complete the worksheet in Teams?</p>	
3	<p>Fractions</p> <p>Can you watch the White Rose videos on fractions, located in the Teams folder? There are also two accompanying worksheets to complete.</p>	

4	Humans on Mars You have another worded Maths challenge this week- Humans on Mars! Can you read the text and answer the questions? Activity located in Teams.	
5	Problem Solving Challenge The ability to solve problems is at the heart of Mathematics. I know sometimes we find multi-step questions difficult so it's important we continue to practise. Can you complete some of the problem solving challenges I have added to Teams? They are in the Mathematics folder in Teams, under 'Problem solving'.	

	Literacy Activities	Completed
1	Up level your sentences! Can you complete the 'Expanding Sentences' worksheet in Teams? It will help you to improve your sentences throughout your story by including more detail.	
2	Creative Writing - Short Story Last week, you should have all completed your short story. This week, I would like you to concentrate on editing your story. Think about what you can do to improve. As we do with our polishing pen in school, you are going to check your work for spelling, punctuation, and up level your sentences.	
3	Reading Task- Jazz Harper This week you are required to read Jazz Harper Chapter 4 and answer the accompanying comprehension sheet.	
4	Over the last few weeks, you have written a detailed setting description for your fictional planet and have written a short story relating to it. This week, I would like you to design a travel brochure or poster, advertising your planet and why it would be a good/bad place to visit! You can do this on paper or as an online document.	
5	Your weekly spelling list is included in the Literacy file in this week's home learning in Teams. Please practise writing these words in your best joined up handwriting.	

	Topic Activities	Completed
1	<p>This week, we will be learning all about the ISS (International Space Station). Can you watch the PowerPoint in Teams and complete the accompanying worksheet?</p> <p>If we have any clear evenings/nights, see if you can spot the ISS. Here is a photo from the other weekend where I was lucky enough to catch it going by, I even got Mars in the same photo, so I was very happy with myself!</p> 	
2	<p>Scientists are always looking for new views of our planet to learn more about its climate, surface, cycles and how humans are impacting the planet. Imagine you are an astronaut capturing images of the earth from the cupola of the ISS. What do you view in your images and how could you share your camera view of the planet through art?</p> <p>First, find out what the cupola is. Begin by exploring the parts of the ISS by taking a tour of the space station, available at: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jbZ7IDlVeIo</p> <p>Next, go to the Windows on Earth website, available at: https://www.windowsonearth.org/</p> <p>Can you find a view of Earth that captures your attention? Do the astronaut's photos of Earth look like you thought they would from space?</p> <p>Can you select an image from 'Regions' and look at it in more depth? Can you compare the image to a Google Map view?</p>	

	<p>Next, I would like you to sketch your image and the relative location of the area. Can you research the science and the location of the region/image content? For example, the clouds, weather, landforms.</p> <p>Some other interesting websites;</p> <p>https://spaceadventures.com/iss-cupola-room-with-extraordinary-view-2/</p>	
3	<p>Children's Mental Health week</p> <p>This week is Children's mental health week and the theme is 'Express Yourself!'. I have uploaded a PowerPoint to teams, which includes an activity that will allow you to get creative and express yourself.</p>	
4	<p>Weekly Welsh</p> <p>Weekly Welsh is happening right across our school. You can find this week's sheet by clicking on the link below or going to the Welsh Language page on our Website.</p> <p>Take your time to watch the film clips before you practice the patterns and make sure that you can remember some of the vocabulary.</p> <p>Practice the patterns with your family or if you are talking to friends online, be brave and ask them: Sut wyt ti?</p> <p>You can listen to the story, and then perhaps mute the sound and have a go at reading one or two of the phrases yourself.</p> <p>This week our pattern is all about saying how we are feeling by using these phrases: Sut wyt ti? Dw i'n..... You can also find out how other people are feeling.</p> <p>The story this week finds out how each of the friends are feeling and we have a band of the week: Calan who play traditional music in a very modern way.
