Look at the PowerPoint in your Literacy folder. (<b>See Teams - General - 01.03.21 - Literacy</b>)</p> <p>This asks you to design a new note and you should incorporate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A famous person on one side of the note</li> <li>• A special place on the other</li> <li>• Welsh patterns on the background.</li> <li>• A quote with an element of Welshness in it ( a proverb or saying, quote from a book or poem, a song lyric) this can be in English or Welsh but you must know what it means.</li> </ul>

You might want to find out about Sports stars, TV stars, singers, actors, artists, eco warriors or politicians.</li> <li>• You should produce a fact sheet or short autobiography of your personality.</li> <li>• You must say why they deserve to be on the note.</li> </ul> <p>You may work on paper or on Word. Any work online should be saved to your home learning folder in your One Drive. This is not a Powerpoint presentation task.</p>	
3	<p><b>Wednesday</b></p> <p>Continuing with our '<b>design some new money for Wales</b>' task, today I would like you to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Research a famous Welsh place. It could be a natural feature such as a lake, river, mountain or beach. Alternatively, it could be a man-made building such as a stadium, theatre, or bridge</li> <li>• You should produce a fact sheet for your place.</li> <li>• You must say why it deserves to be on the note.</li> </ul>	
4	<p><b>Thursday</b></p> <p>Your task today is to source a quote to put on your note. You can use the websites on the PowerPoint to help you find a quote. It should be a Welsh saying or proverb, a quote from a song or poem.</p> <p>Now you have collected all the relevant information, can you design your special 'Welsh money' note?
