It doesn't have to be long. Maybe just a verse and chorus. Record yourself performing it and send it to me. Act out a scene from one of your favourite books. You could do this with members of your family or with some of your friends in class. Record yourself performing it and send it to me. Draw a picture of your favourite story, scene from a story or your favourite character. You can use whatever you have in the house. Be creative and impress me. |
